

Carve a Wood Spirit in Bark with Paul Giasson

The wood spirit is a favourite carving, whether you do hand-held carving, mallet and chisel carving or power carving. Surprisingly, it is one of the simplest carving projects that a beginner can create and one where each and every wood spirit caricature you carve has its unique look.

Join me, Paul Giasson local artist, as I take you through the steps to carve a classic wood spirit on Cottonwood bark. Instruction will focus on layout of faces, step by step strategy for carving a face, eye placement and facial expression. Please bring your own tools.

You will need:

- carving glove
- pencil
- 2 V-tools 90 degree angle
- gouges - 3/8 round and 3/16 round
- bench knives - 1/1/4 - 1/1/2 inches along with a detail knife

That's all you need, and you're on your way to bring home a great carving. I have only one rule "let's have some fun".
