Wood Spirit in Bark
With Paul Giasson

Paul Giasson is a Winnipeg traditional carver, specializing in bark Wood Spirits. He carves with numerous clubs. Participants in the class will carve a wood spirit in Cottonwood bark.

Instruction will focus on layout of faces, a step by step strategy for carving faces, eye placement and facial expression. Cottonwood bark can be found along Winnipeg's rivers and is selected for its unique shapes and easy- to-carve nature.
