

Cold cast bronze - Marlin head

The workshop demonstrates the cast bronze painting technique. I have included a pattern for the marlin head which participants will need to carve & sand prior to the workshop, so it is ready for sealing & painting. The subject matter isn't critical, if you have any other carved piece, roughly miniature size (up to 8"), that can be used instead of the marlin head.

- The piece will be sealed with Rust-oleum oil rubbed bronze primer
- The piece is painted with the bronze coating (Sculpt Nouveau)
- Once dry, the Clear Guard sealer is applied

The primer, sealer & bronze coating are supplied

Materials required:

- Marlin head or other carved piece
- Paint brush, inexpensive - flat or filbert type
- Hair dryer - it would speed up the drying process if we had 3 or 4. If you have one, bring it along
