

Manitoba 150 carving challenge - the Beauty and History of Manitoba

Each year Prairie Canada Carving Championship issues a special challenge for carvers. We have had the duck head challenge, the fish challenge, and the Great White North challenge. This year, we are embracing Manitoba's 150 birthday, and challenging carvers to enter pieces of their work to celebrate the milestone. The guidelines are: carve a piece that represents or reminds you of Manitoba. Some obvious choices may be crocuses, or bison, or our Grey Cup winning Bombers! The carvings need to fit on an 8" x 8" surface, as we will be displaying them on small pedestals. The rules are simple: if it is a carving, it is eligible. And there is no entry fee. There will be some prize draws for those who have entered this challenge. Most of all, have fun with your entries.
