More Information

1. **Covid-19 Restrictions:** AWCA will be following all local Covid-19 restrictions at the time of the school. Currently AWCA requires that all participants be fully vaccinated to take any of our classes. In addition, our classes follow the local masking and physical distancing rules. We will keep you informed as these rules may change.
2. **Accommodations:** Carving in the Park is held in Sherwood Park Alberta (a suburb of Edmonton) there are several hotels in the area. In addition, we have a limited number of camping spots available at the Carving in the Park venue.
3. **Shipping - Pat Godin's Class:** There is pre-carving for Pat's Class. Part of your registration fee is a cut-out (Pat's new Pattern), eyes and a reference pack that will be forwarded to you once your deposit is received. If you are new to Carving in the Park, please provide us with your contact information. If you are returning to Carving in the Park, please let us know if you have changed your address since last year. Castings of the Blue- Wing Teal are available for carvers who do not wish to do the pre-carving.

4. **Shipping equipment to Sherwood Park:** You can send things to us in advance, and we will make sure it is held for you.
5. **Borrowing Equipment from AWCA:** If you are flying into Edmonton to attend Carving in the park and do not wish to bring your compressor, lights etc. please let me know in advance and I will arrange to provide this equipment to you.
6. **Meals:** Lunch during the six days of Carving in the Park is provided as part of your class fee. You will be responsible for the remainder of your meals. Please let us know if you have any allergies.
