

The theme of our special display this year will be: [“This is Whooooo we are!”](#)

Carvers are invited to prepare, carve, and finish an owl carving that will make up part of our display. Here are some general guidelines:

- Carvings are “flats” as these will be displayed on a flat background; there is no need to carve the backside of the piece.
- The carvings should be anywhere from ½ inch to 1 inch in thickness.
- Carvings must be roughly 3 inches in height. Carvers wanting to modify the dimensions (height, width or details) may do so, keeping in mind that overly large carvings may not fit in the display.
- Carvers are encouraged to paint their pieces although natural finish pieces are welcome as well.
- There is no fee to enter pieces in this display.
- Every participant will have their name entered in a draw for a special prize; there will be a separate draw for junior participants entering carvings. Carvers who submit multiple entries will receive a separate draw entry for each carving.
